

# Social Service Clinic

The Social Service Clinic is organized by the New Hope Christian Church and the Light and Salt Association. This service will be available starting October 1, 2021.

The medical insurance system in the United States is complicated and confusing. For example, it is difficult to understand the differences between the Affordable Care (Obamacare), Medicare, and Medicaid. It is difficult to apply for these services and to understand how they work. Moreover, green card holders do not want to be considered as a public charge, as this status might work against them during their journey to citizenship. The Social Service Clinic has health insurance navigators who provide information and counsel on how to apply for insurance and other government benefits.

The Light and Salt Association has been designated as an organization that helps people to purchase personal health insurance and to apply for Medicaid since 2014. Many government-certified health insurance navigators are available to help guide individuals through the complicated process of signing up for insurance and other need-based programs.
